

Indians JV Team Tops Broadway 30 - 23

The Fort Defiance Indians Junior Varsity squad topped the Broadway Gobblers 30 – 23 at Broadway on December 13. The FDHS squad outscored the Gobblers on a 10 – 2 run in the third quarter, coming back from a 10 – 9 deficit, to take the lead which they didn't relinquish.

Isaac Marshall opened the scoring for the Indians with a three pointer. After a BHS score, Carter Berry scored on a drive to make it 5 – 2. The Gobblers came back to 5 – 4 before multiple turnovers by the Fort guards and missed three point shots allowed the Gobblers to move ahead 6 – 5. Gus Gutshall then hit a nice spinning shot to give the Indians the lead, 7 – 6, after one quarter.

Scoring was hard to find in the second quarter. With 3:01 to go, Isaac hit a jumper to give FDHS a 9 – 6 lead in the before Broadway came back to take a 10 – 9 lead. Aided by several more turnovers, Broadway took this lead at halftime.

In the third quarter, Evan Braun hit a layup to pull the Indians ahead 11 – 10. Tripp Hanger added a layup as did Carter to make it 15 – 10. Carter then grabbed an offensive rebound and put it back in. BHS got a free throw and Rhylan Martin banged in a jumper to give the Indians a 19 – 11 lead. After BHS scored the next three points, Tripp's deuce gave Fort a comfortable 21 – 14 lead after three quarters.

Isaac hit another three pointer to push the lead to ten, 24 – 14. BHS scored to make it 24 – 16 with 3:27 to go but Gus grabbed an offensive rebound and scored to return the lead to ten. Carter and Tripp both hit both ends of one-and-one free throws down the stretch to give the Indians the 30 – 23 victory.

The Indians have now won three in a row and improved their record to 3 – 2. They play at Turner Ashby Thursday night.
